## Summer Football Senior Information Sheet

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Belnorth Summer Football is a social competition that runs from the 8<sup>th</sup> of October through to the of 17<sup>th</sup> December. It is a 6-a-side competition played on small sided fields.

Games are played on Tuesday nights with the following kick off times:

- 6:15pm, 7:05pm & 7:55pm

### Cost and Registration:

- \$85 per senior player
- \$70 per junior player
- Plus \$12 per player for insurance for non-Capital Football players (ie players that have NOT registered in a Capital Football Winter or Futsal Comps)

### Season:

- Divisions will consist of 6 to 10 teams. Each division will play a 9-game season followed by a 2 week final series.

In the event of cancellation, games will not be rescheduled, competition organisers will endeavour to let teams know ASAP when ACT Sportsgrounds have closed the fields. We will use email and the TeamApp to notify of game changes so please ensure you all have registered on the Belnorth FC team app <https://belnorthfootballclub.teamapp.com/>

### Rules:

*Please remember this is a social competition and should be played that way.*

1. Games are 45 minutes – 20-minute halves with a 5-minute half time break.
2. Teams must have 4 players on the field or they will forfeit.
3. Teams must wear the same uniform.
4. Goalkeepers must wear a different shirt.
5. Regular football rules apply EXCEPT:
  - a- No sliding within 2m of another player, this will result in the player being cautioned and an indirect free kick to the opposing team.

- b- No Offsides
  - c- Substitutions are allowed at any time, but player being substituted must be off the field before the substitute player can enter.
6. Referees will be provided where possible and can caution and send players off.
  7. Players that are cautioned for slide tackles will be required to leave the field for 5 minutes. Players sent off will be required to leave the field for the whole game and may face further disciplinary action.
  8. In the event a referee cannot be provided, the home team will need to officiate.
  9. **Mixed Only Rule** – Once a male scores a goal, a female must score before a male can score again, this resets at half time.

To increase the enjoyment of the competition we will endeavour to grade teams into a similar level of competition. Teams will be organised into divisions depending on their ability. Therefore, teams are asked to provide divisions and/or the skill level of their players along with their previous team names on the nomination form to assist in grading the teams.

### **Team Duties:**

Teams will be responsible for setting up fields and goals for the 6:15pm games and teams playing the 7:55pm game will be responsible for the pack down of fields and goals.

Goals can be collected from the containers in the middle of the fields and returned to the containers upon the last game of the evening.

An information session on field set up and pack down will be given to team managers and coaches pre-season. **Each team must send a representative.**

### **Nominating a team**

**Nominations must be received by 27th September 2019**

Teams with more than 2 unregistered players from this point will forfeit all games until the situation is remedied.

Teams with 1 or 2 unregistered players will be able to play but the unregistered players will not be allowed to participate until they've registered.
