In assuming a technical leadership role, the TD provides mentorship to coaches and players in all programs and fosters good sportsmanship in a safe and fun environment.</p>

- Create a player development model to foster technical excellence in accordance with FFA National Curriculum guidelines, including designing any programs or opportunities to support this model
- Source technical development resources and offer age-appropriate skills training sessions to foster player development

***Support Belnorth Coaches***

- To make recommendations to Belnorth about coaches and their suitability for the role
- To make recommendations about how coaches can improve their football understanding, including advising Belnorth where a coach doesn't meet minimum expectations
- To observe coaches at training sessions and on game day and provide tailored advice, including tactical advice for the team where appropriate
- Design and administer an overall coach development program to develop coaching expertise to support all player programs, including developing and creating manuals and tools as required
- Support professional development opportunities for coaches and foster the ongoing attainment of coaching certification to build a strong coaching cohort for the future
- To promote the importance of teams adopting a suitable style of play
- Provide guidance tailored towards the Seniors program to improve coaching standards

**Key Deliverables:**

- Establish a cohort of coaches to assist with the delivery of training programs, gradings, workshops etc.
- Organise and run age group training sessions for U5-U11
- Support training sessions for U12-U18
- Promote Coach education to the Belnorth community
- Organise a Goalkeeper training program
- Increase Belnorth community understanding of the FFA Curriculum
- Conduct Grading for U10-U18s, including team and coach placements
- Conduct an end of season coaching season survey
- Run a preseason skills program for junior players
- Focus on player retention & growth
- Introduce clinics & programs to support in-house player development
- Keep costs within the agreed budget, including maintaining a spreadsheet of current and projected expenditures
- Regularly brief the Belnorth Committee throughout the season
