



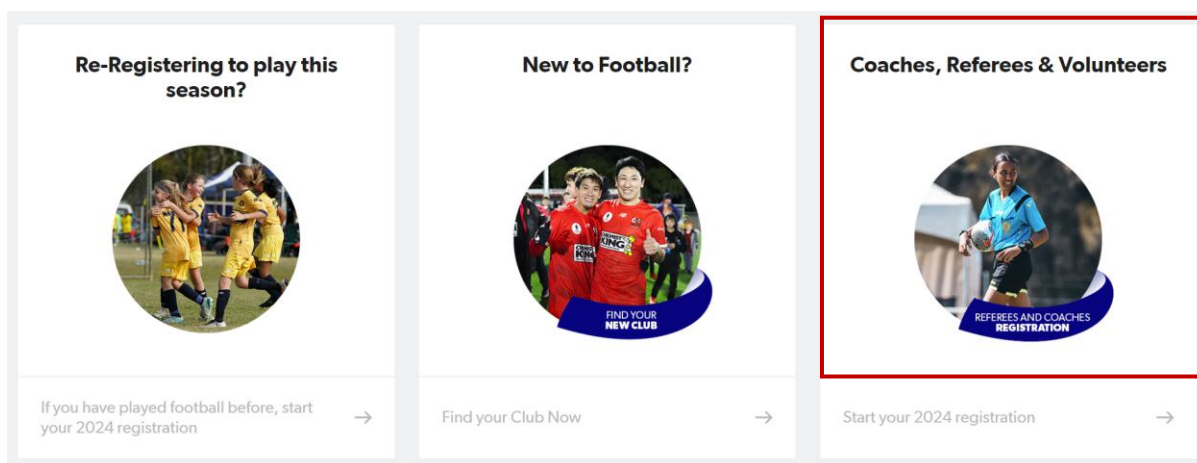

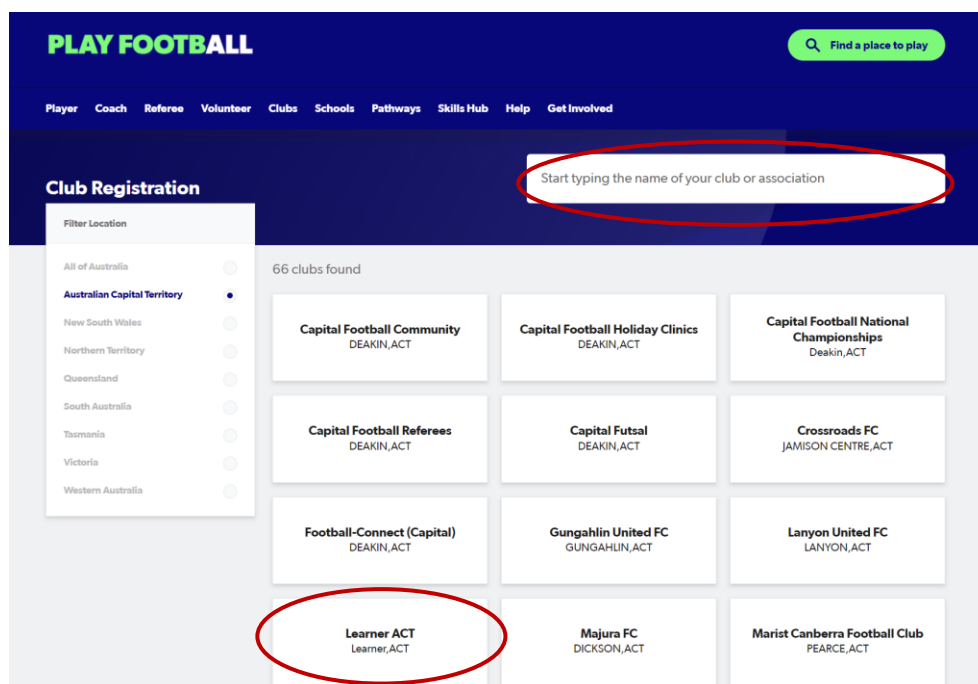
### ENROLLING IN JUNIOR FOOTBALL MATCH OFFICIAL COURSE

1. Go to [PlayFootball](https://playfootball.com.au), click on 'Coaches, Referees and Volunteers'



2. Click on 'Learner ACT' (page 3 of ACT Football Clubs, or use search bar)

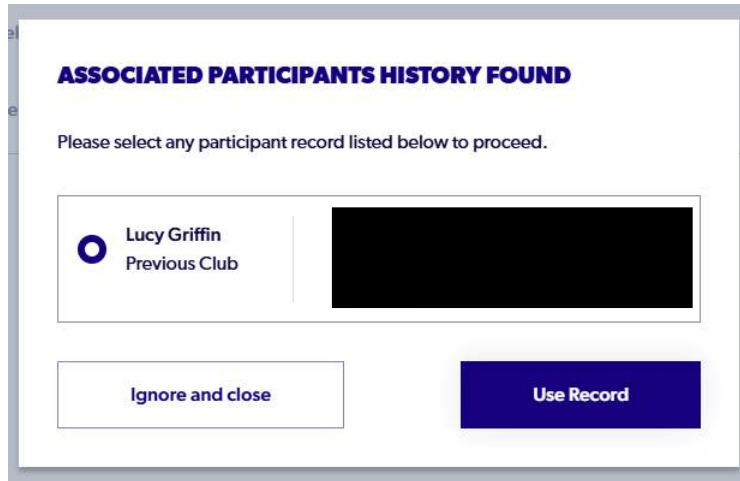


- You will be directed to the **new** PlayFootball login page – use your existing details, check the boxes and select ‘Sign In’

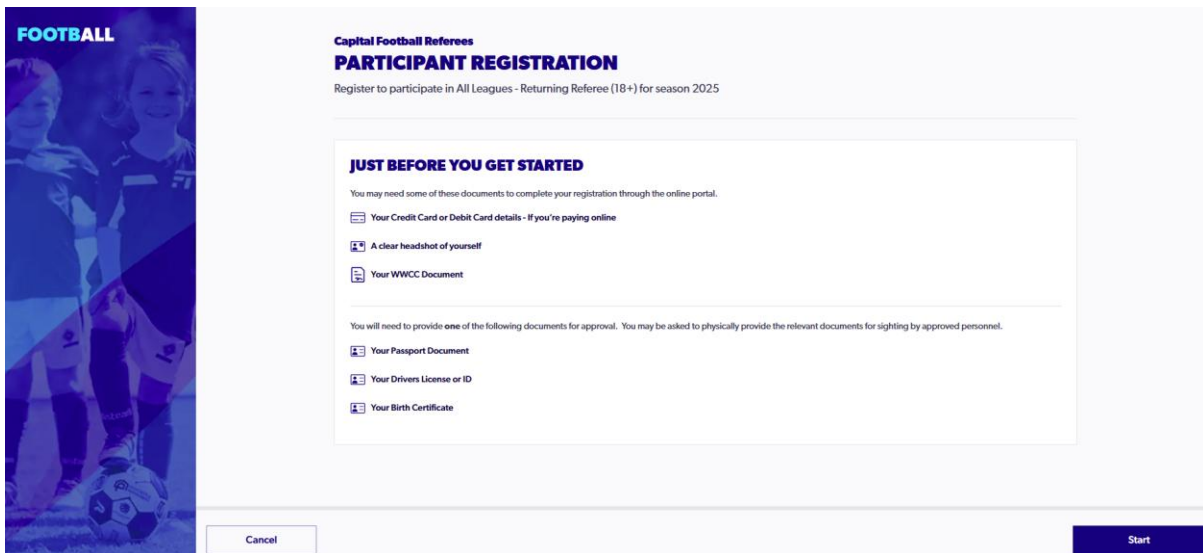
- Select ‘Details’ for the Learner Registration - Referee product, and then select ‘Register’ on the next page.

- Choose if you are registering yourself or someone else associated with your account. You should get a popup with your previous details, select ‘Use Record’.





- Ensure you have all documents ready for registration, this includes a WWVP card (from [Access Canberra](#)) for participants aged 16 and older. You will need to have a volunteer check at a minimum.



- Follow the prompts, ensuring that the steps on the left of the screen show green ticks. **No tick means there is required information missing** – you will need to go back to the step with missing information.

8. If aged 16 and older, enter WWVP details – *you will not be able to register without a WWVP card*
  - a. Enter the issue date as five years before the expiry date

11. Click on 'Learner (Football Account)' and login using PlayFootball details
